PURPOSE:

The Open Season Expo (Expo) is sponsored by Open Season, LLC. The purpose of this Expo is to enable its attendees to see, hear, examine, and purchase the latest developments, equipment, supplies, and services which are represented by the Exhibitors.

GENERAL:

The words Open Season, LLC shall mean its officers, committees, agents, or employees acting for them in the management of the Expo. Open Season, LLC reserves the right to render all interpretations and to establish further regulations as may be deemed necessary for the general success of the Expo. Open Season, LLC reserves the right to decline, prohibit, or expel an exhibit which, in its sole judgment, is out of character for the Expo and/or is in violation of this contract or any rules or regulations now or hereafter in effect.

Dimensions of all exhibit areas are believed to be accurately stated on the floor plans. However, Open Season, LLC will not assume liability for any discrepancy that may actually occur. Open Season, LLC will not assume responsibility for the temperature levels of the Exhibit Facility during set up, and show tear down. Open Season, LLC reserves the option, to substitute comparable display space if required by any unforeseen circumstances, or to refund the exhibit fee. Exhibitors shall be bound by all pertinent laws, codes, and regulations of municipal or other authorities having jurisdiction over the Exhibit Facility or the conducting of said exhibit, together with the rules and regulations of the owners and operators of the Exhibit Facility.

SOLICITATION:

Distribution of advertising material and Exhibitor solicitation of any sort shall be restricted to the Exhibitor's booth. Exhibitor's display and/or product may not extend into any aisle. No Exhibitor shall arrange his/her exhibit so as to obscure or prejudice adjacent Exhibitors in the sole opinion of Open Season, LLC.

TAXES AND LICENSES:

Exhibitor shall be responsible for obtaining any licenses, permits, or approvals required under local, state, or federal law applicable to their activity at the Expo. Exhibitor shall be responsible for obtaining any tax identification numbers and

that shall become due to any governmental authority in connection with their activities at the Expo.

CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY:

Cancellation of all or part of the exhibit space must be in writing to Open Season, LLC. Exhibitors cancelling sixty (60) days before show will receive a full refund. No refunds issued after 60 days before show. If the Exhibitor does not make full payment when due under the terms of this contract, Open Season, LLC reserves the right to terminate this contract and the Exhibitor shall be responsible for the payment to Open Season, LLC of all amounts which would have been due Open Season, LLC under the terms of this contract.

INSURANCE:

Exhibitor shall carry its own insurance. Open Season, LLC and the Expo facility assume no responsibility for the safety of the properties of the Exhibitor, its officers, agents, or employees from theft. Damages by fire, accident, or other causes whatsoever: Exhibitor expressly agrees to save and hold harmless Open Season, LLC, the decorator/exposition company and the Expo facility and their respective management, agent, and employee's from any and all liability resulting from injuries or damage to Exhibitor, its agents, employees, persons, and/or properties in connection with the Exhibitor's use of the exhibit space.

DEFAULT OF OCCUPANCY:

It is further agreed that actual occupation of the exhibit space by an exhibit is essential. Should the Exhibitor be unable to occupy the space by December 1 of the previous year, then Open Season, LLC is authorized to occupy or cause said space to be occupied in such a manner as it may deem in the best interest of the Expo, without any rebate or allowance whatsoever to the Exhibitor and without in any way releasing said Exhibitor from any liability, or from any of its obligations under this contract. Exhibitor expressly agrees to pay Open Season, LLC the full amount set forth in this contract.

BUILDING OCCUPANCY:

Open Season, LLC shall not liable for the non-fulfillment of this contract as to the delivery of exhibit space if non-delivery is due to any of the following causes by reason of the facility being damaged or destroyed by fire, an act of God, public enemy, war or insurrection, strikes, the authority of law, postponement or cancellation, of the Expo, or for any cause beyond its control. It will however, in the event of its not able to hold an exhibit for any of the above named reasons, reimburse Exhibitor on a pro-rated basis for any amounts paid, less any and all legitimate expenses incurred such as – but not limited to rent, advertising, salaries, operating costs, etc.

PROTECTION OF FACILITIES:

Nothing shall be posted on, tacked, nailed, screwed, or otherwise attached to the columns, walls, floors, or other parts of the exhibit facility without the written permission of Open Season, LLC.

Packing, unpacking, and any assembly of exhibits shall be done only in designated areas and in conformity with the direction of Open Season, LLC, and the convention facility.

MANAGER OR ASSISTANT BOOTHS:

The booth package (a 10' x 10' space with back and side wall draping) is provided by Open Season, LLC. If an Exhibitor plans to install a completely constructed display of such a character that the Exhibitor will not require or desire the use of standard booth equipment, no part of the display shall project as to obstruct the view of adjacent boots. No display may exceed 8' height on the back wall or be higher than the side wall specifications without the written consent of Open Season, LLC.

INSTALLATION:

The specific requirements as to the time for installation will be posted on the website.

DISMANTLING AT CLOSING OF SHOW AND NOT BEFORE:

Open Season, LLC expressly reserves the right to determine rules subject to all installations and dismantling done by any Exhibitor at the Expo.

This contract has been reviewed by legal counsel to Open Season, LLC and is approved as to its form and execution. This contract becomes effective upon the date of acceptance by the Exhibitor/Lessee.
